

Coco Learns to Save Money

A Financial Literacy Worksheet for Ages 7–9

Coco's Story



Coco gets R10 every week for pocket money. She wants to buy a new skipping rope that costs R40. Instead of spending all her money, she saves R10 each week in her piggy bank. After 4 weeks, she has enough to buy the skipping rope. Coco feels proud and happy!

ACTIVITY 1: Coco's Savings Plan

How much does Coco save after 2 weeks?

$$R10 \times 2 = R \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

How many weeks does she need to save to buy something that costs R50?

$$R50 \div R10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ weeks}$$
